**1st gear: our purpose.
a relationship with God!**

If you want to experience true peace and freedom, you have to realize that God loves you and created you for a relationship with him and has a plan and purpose for your life!

“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.” (John 3:16-17)

**2nd gear:

If we are not paying attention and we run our bike off the road & hit a tree, that is our fault and there will be severe consequences: hospital, bike totaled, and possibly death. The Bible says there are consequences for our sins.

**“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”
(Romans 6:23)**

3rd gear: Jesus died for our sins

There is no question that all of us deserve to die and go to hell, but the good news is we do not have to because Jesus died on the cross for us! He died in our place and paid for our sin to give us freedom!!

“For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God.”
(1 Peter 3:18)



4th gear: the plan. we are to receive Jesus!

how do you receive Jesus?

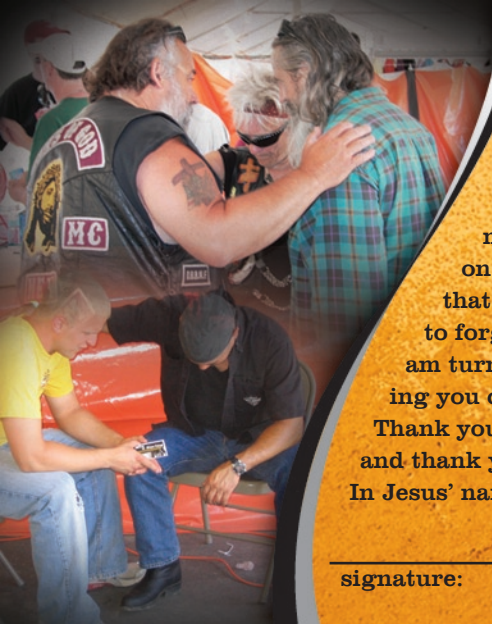
1. Admit your sin. (God, I have messed up.)
